FOUNDATION HIGHLIGHTS

The ARMA International Educational Foundation (AIEF), a non-profit organization dedicated to funding research and education in the records and information management field, is dependent on its endowment fund. All initiatives funded by the AIEF Endowment come from the interest proceeds of the endowment contributions of individual records and information management professionals, ARMA Chapters and vendor partners who recognize the importance this work.

FOCUS ON RESEARCH REPORTS – Articles that CFCs can use

One of the primary benefits that the AIEF brings to RIM professionals is the collection of research reports that are paid for by the Foundation (often with the assistance and support of local ARMA chapters and regions). These reports deal with topics of current interest to the RIM community and are made available without charge from the Foundation's website. To increase awareness of this resource, Pilar McAdam, coordinator for the Chapter Foundation Champions (CFCs), will write a series of articles for distribution to the CFCs that highlight the available research reports. These articles can then be included in chapter newsletters, posted to chapter websites, or sent out via email to chapter members. The first article should be distributed by the end of March.

IS THE CFC ASSIGNED TO YOUR CHAPTER CORRECT?

Chapter Foundation Champions (CFCs) are the representatives, supporters, boosters, and cheerleaders for the AIEF at the local level. The Foundation relies on our network of CFCs to receive and distribute AIEF news and information, and to promote Foundation activities and goals.
