DONORS CAN HELP STRETCH THEIR PLEDGES BY GIVING EARLY ON OCTOBER 28, 2009

The ARMA International Educational Foundation wants to make donors aware of a special giving opportunity on October 28. The AIEF, which is administered from Pittsburgh, PA, has elected to participate in the Pittsburgh Gives campaign (PittsburghGives.org). Starting at 10:00 a.m. Eastern time, if you donate to the Foundation, 50% of your gift will be matched by the Pittsburgh Foundation. So, your \$100 contribution becomes \$150 and your \$2000 becomes \$3000. This 50% match will continue until the Pittsburgh Foundation uses all of the \$200,000 they have allocated toward matching funds.

Susan Whitmire, Chairman of the Foundation, says "This is a great opportunity for those who already plan to contribute to the foundation and a special incentive for those persons who have considered giving in the past but are looking for a great reason to begin. The generous gift of the Pittsburgh Foundation is open to all charities headquartered in the Pittsburgh area so we hope donors will plan now to make their donation right away on October 28."

According to Foundation Administrator Preston Shimer the key to participating in this event, which is a first for the Foundation, is to register on the Pittsburgh Foundation website as a donor before October 28. "Even though this is a first-time event for us, we have been told that the matching funds will probably run out in less than an hour since many Pittsburgh-based charities are participating. For that reason we encourage all donors to register early and be ready and donate at 10:00 a.m. Eastern time on October 28."
